🗱 In Romans 8:1-4, 8-9, Paul says that because our flesh cannot please God, being in Christ and therefore in the Spirit is primarily a gift from above. How does that reality affect the way you feel about victory?

🥊 Do you wonder if you have reached a plateau in your Christian life, as if your Christian growth has leveled off? Why do you think this is?

🥐 What sins have you struggled with for many years that make it difficult to believe that you can have victory over?'
