 Does God’s grace come with conditions? Explain your answer.

 Is it possible to receive grace by faith without one’s life changing? Why or why not? Let 1 Cor. 6:20, John 14:15, James 1:25, Ephesians 2:10, Romans 5:20-21 inform your thoughts.

**3** Paul says in Titus 2:13 that Christians wait for a blessed hope in Christ’s glorious appearing. What are some of the things that non-Christians are waiting for?

 How does a believer’s “hope,” according to Titus 2:13, add meaning to everyday life?

 What does it look like for a Christian to wait for the “blessed hope?” Is it a passive or active process? Explain your answer.
