- 1 **How has God used both your current circumstances and our study of Daniel to grow your prayer life?**

- 2 **Read through Psalm 2 as a group.** Look for how the passage describes the wicked, God, and His people.
 - ♥ *How do the wicked express their rebellion towards God? (1-3)*

 - ♥ *How does God respond to the wicked? (4-9)*

 - ♥ *What should our response be? (10-12)*

 - ♥ *Discuss how this Psalm connects to Daniel 9:20-27. How does these truths meet you in your current situation?*

- 3 **When Babylon fell, Daniel turned back to the prophecies of God (See Jer. 25:11).** Where do you turn in God's word when you need to get balance in the midst of transition or trial?

4 Knowing that history and future are firmly in the hands of God and that His plan is sure, how should Christians live until His plan is brought to fruition?

♥ *What fears do you think Daniel had as he heard about the destruction that was to come?*

♥ *What fears do you have when you think about the end of the world as you know it?*
