- Read through Psalm 2 as a group. Look for how the passage describes the wicked, God, and His people.
  - How do the wicked express their rebellion towards God? (1-3)
  - ♥ How does God respond to the wicked? (4-9)
  - ♥ What should our response be? (10-12)
  - Discuss how this Psalm connects to Daniel 9:20-27. How does these truthes meet you in your current situation?
- (3) When Babylon fell, Daniel turned back to the prophecies of God (See Jer. 25:11). Where do you turn in God's word when you need to get balance in the midst of transition or trial?
