- 1 What are some excuses that people often have when thinking about discipleship?** Think also of fears that people have when it comes to discipleship. What keeps people from this core value? Pray together that God would use each person in the group to make disciples.
- 2 Some don't make disciples, because they feel it is a task for experts only.** Take a moment to demystify and deprofessionalize discipleship as a group. What would the simple methods of 1) committing time in love, 2) communicating truth through the Word, and 3) cultivating trust by modeling Christlikeness look like in your relationships? What does growing in this core value look like?
- 3 In the opening of Deuteronomy 29, Moses walks the people of Israel down memory lane.** How have you seen that remembering the past could help you move forward in the present?

⚙️ *What events or circumstances in your past have dramatically shaped your current life in a positive way?*

- 4 There is an acute warning in Deuteronomy 29:18-19 about being drawn away from God by idolatry or being poisoned in heart by bitterness.** How does idolatry and bitterness affect people?

♥️ *When do you most often struggle with the temptation to be drawn away from the Lord or to stew in bitterness and resentment? How can the group pray for you?*
