How do these verses help you take God at his word about his promises?

3 Discuss the following thought from Donald Macleod about the virgin birth. "The virgin birth is posted on guard at the door of the mystery of Christmas; and none of us must think of hurrying past it. It stands on the threshold of the New Testament, blatantly supernatural, defying our rationalism, informing us that all that follows belongs to the same order as itself and that if we find it offensive there is no point in proceeding further." (The Person of Christ, 37)
