Michael Wilcock wrote, "What then can Jesus do with a group of disciples still so unbelieving, slow-witted, swollen-headed, and nar-
row-minded, except take them with him on another year's course of teaching?" Skim over the rest of the book of Luke and share with the
group some of the upcoming lessons that Jesus will teach his disciples. Be encouraged by looking up Acts 1:1-3, 8.

2 We witnessed the many failures of the disciples. Take one of their failures and share with the group how you have seen that weakness in your life.

Sleeping when they should have been praying.

Talking when they should have been listening.

A lack of faith to believe that God could do great things.

A spirit of rivalry with their team of believers.

Judgmental sectarianism towards people outside of their team.

A desire for vengeance on those who had done them wrong.

Not giving up simple conveniences to follow Christ.

Not immediately submitting to the call of Christ.

Longing for the things of this world, rather than staying focused on Christ.

Thabiti Anyabwile gives a list of different ways that Christians can be tribal. Take one of the areas and discuss. How is that area of tribalism could distract Christian disciples from living on mission.

Male vs. female (gender tribalism)

Urban vs. suburban (community tribalism)
