Personal Pronouns

(Acts 10:19-20, 13:2)

Personal Properties

(1 Cor. 12:11)

HOLY SPIRIT IS GOD

Scripture identifies Him as God

(Acts. 5:1-4)

The Holy Spirit is identified as the Yahweh of the OT

(Isa. 6:9-10/Acts 28:25-27, Ps. 95:7/Heb. 3)

The Holy Spirit possesses divine attributes

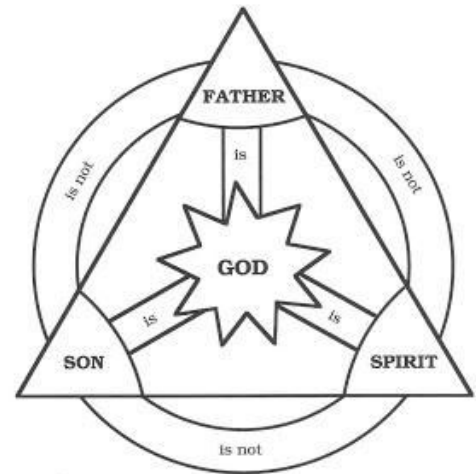
(Heb. 9:14, Ps. 139:7-10, 1 Cor. 2:10-11)

The Holy Spirit does Divine work

(John 3:5-6)

Though distinguished from the Father and the Son, the Holy Spirit is represented as equal with the Father and the Son in the great Trinitarian passages of the New Testament

(Matt. 3:16, Matt. 28:19, Eph. 2:18)
