11 who must be silenced because they are upsetting whole families, teaching things they should not teach, for the sake of sordid gain.

12 One of themselves, a prophet of their own, said, "Cretans are always liars, evil beasts, lazy gluttons."

13 This testimony is true. For this cause I severely reprove them sound in the faith.

14 Not paying attention to Jewish myths and commandments of men who turn away from the truth.

15 To the pure, all things are pure; but to those who are defiled and unbelieving, nothing is pure, but both their mind and their conscience are defiled.

16 They profess to know God, but by their deeds they deny Him, being detestable and disobedient and worthless for any good deed.

INSTRUCTIONS TO LEADER/TEACHER OF THE CHURCH

Chapter 2 Theme

2 But as for you, speak the things which are fitting for sound doctrine.

3 Older men are to be temperate, dignified, sensible, sound in faith, in love, in perseverance.

4 Older women likewise are to be reverent in their behavior, not malicious gossips, nor enslaved to much wine, teaching what is good.

5 That they may encourage the young women to love their husbands, to love their children,

6 to be sensible, pure, workers at home, kind, being subject to their own husbands, that the word of God may not be dishonored.

6 Likewise urge the young men to be sensible.

7 In all things show yourself to be an example of good deeds.

8 Purity in doctrine, dignified, in speech which is beyond reproach, in order that the opponent may be put to shame, having nothing bad to say about us.

9 Urge bondslaves to be subject to their own masters in everything, to be well-pleasing, not argumentative, not ill-nattering; but showing all good faith that they may adorn the doctrine of God our Savior in every respect.

10 For the grace of God has appeared, bringing salvation to all men,

11 instructing us to deny ungodliness and worldly desires and to live sensibly, righteously and godly in the present age,

12 looking for the blessed hope and the appearing of the glory of our great God and Savior, Christ Jesus;

13 who gave Himself for us, that He might redeem us from every lawless deed and purify for Himself a people for His own possession, zealous for good deeds.

15 These things speak and exhort and reprove with all authority. Let no one disregard you.
