SERMON DISCUSSION STARTERS



In light of (Gen. 6:5-7) and (II Peter 2:4-9) why did God send the flood? What does the flood reveal about the inevitable fate of those who persist in sin without repentance?



What does the word "remembered" in (Gen. 1:8) mean? What are other ways God remembered His people in Scripture? How does God remember believers today?

Review (Gen. 8:1-14). What does this passage reveal about God's power? About God's plan? How does God reshape people like he reshapes the contours of the earth?

What is significant about the fact that God closed the door to the ark? What is significant about Noah's decision to wait after the ark came to rest? What was the first thing Noah did when his feet touched dry land after a year on the ark, and why is that significant?

What is significant about each of God's promises in (Gen. 8:21-22)? Does this mean God wouldn't punish evil from that day forward? Why or why not? How do these promises still allow for God's justice to prevail?
